

Dr. Olivier Carcuac is a board-certified specialist in periodontology, clinically active in Dubai and a senior researcher at the Department of Periodontology, University of Gothenburg. His research focuses on the etiopathogenesis and treatment of peri-implantitis as well as advanced soft tissue surgical techniques, areas in which he has published numerous scientific articles. Dr. Carcuac is recognized for his innovative surgical contributions, including co-authoring iMuco-Gingival Recessions, the first iPad application in periodontal plastic surgery. Reviewer for several highly ranked international journals, he is a sought-after lecturer and has received multiple awards throughout his career.



Dr. Ausra Ramanauskaite is a specialist in periodontology and oral surgery. In 2023 she defended the habilitation and obtained a private docent title at the Goethe University, Frankfurt am Main, Germany.

Currently, Ausra Ramanauskaite is working at the oral surgery and implantology department at Goethe University, Frankfurt am Main, Germany. Ausra is a member of a leadership groups of National Osteology Groups Germany, a member of Osteology Foundation Expert Council. She also serves as an advisor for the Editorial Board of European Association for Osseointegration (EAO). Ausra has authored numerous international peer-reviewed publications and is active in the research field of peri-implant pathology, soft- and hard-tissue regeneration.



Professor Iain Chapple is former Director of Research, Institute of Clinical Sciences (2016-2022), Dean of the Dental School (2016-2020) at Birmingham University UK. He has published 15-textbooks, 44-chapters and >310 papers. Iain was awarded: The Royal College of Surgeons Tomes medal (2011); International Association Dental Research Distinguished Scientist (2018); European Federation of Periodontology Eminence Award (2022) and MBE in the 2022 Queens New Year's Honour's. He leads a regional periodontal service (referral base 6 million) and a national oral care service for adults with Epidermolysis Bullosa. He has a strong interest in mechanisms underpinning periodontal-systemic disease links and in immune-microbial interactions. He acts as an honorary consultant to the Office of the Chief Dental Officer for England.
